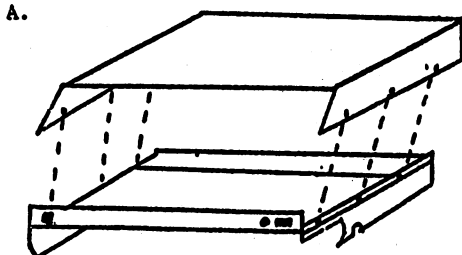


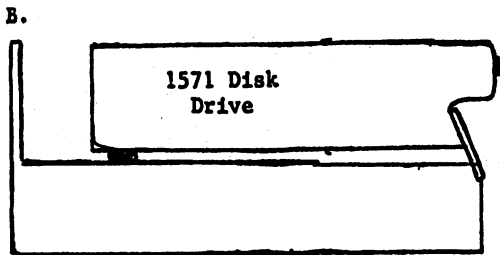
# **128 COMMAND CENTER** Installation Guide

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\* **WARNING: DO NOT ATTEMPT INSTALLATION WITH COMMAND CENTER PLUGGED IN** \*  
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1. Remove top from unit. (Illus. A)
2. Place drive(s) on drive support. Be sure that they are moved forward so the front panel butts against them. (Illus. B)

IF YOU HAVE ONLY ONE DRIVE GO TO STEP 9

3. Plug the drive power cable(s) into outlet(s) on the back panel and feed the other end(s) through the cable port and plug them into the drive(s). Turn the drives to the ON position. (Illus. C & D)

4. Plug the drive serial cable(s) into the drive(s) and feed the computer end under the drive support and out the front of the unit.

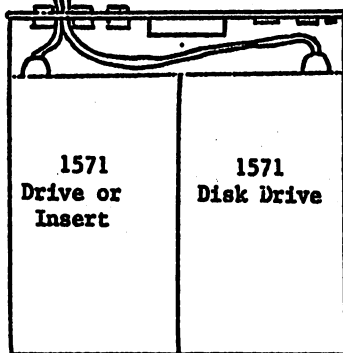
5. Plug your monitor and printer power cords into outlets on the back panel. Next run the system cables through the cable port of the back panel. Feed the monitor cable under the drive support, and out the front of the unit. Do the same with the power supply cord, except run the end through the small hole on the right side of the unit. Connect the printer cable to the drive. (Illus. D-E)

IF YOU HAVE A MODEM GO TO STEP 10

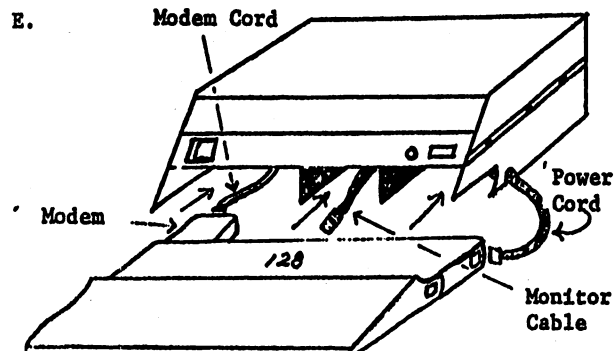
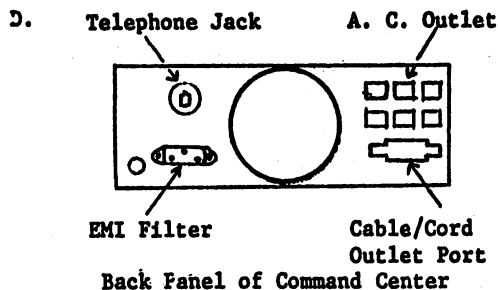
6. Place the CPU in front of the unit. Connect all of the cables to the appropriate ports on the CPU. Turn all peripheral power switches to the ON position. (Slide the CPU into the unit.) (Illus E)

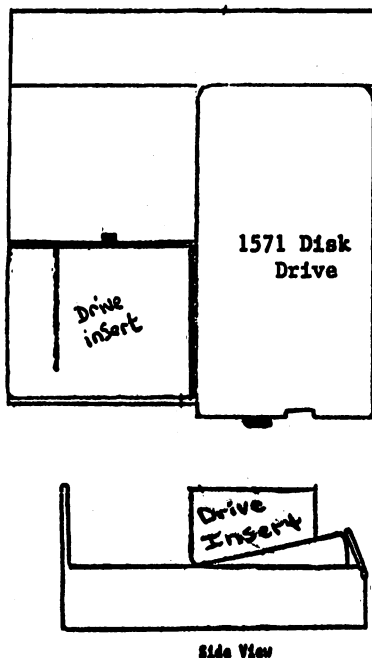
7. Attach the top to the unit using the screws supplied.

8. Connect the main power cord to the back panel and a wall outlet.

9. If you have only one drive, the drive must be placed on the right side of unit. Place the Drive Insert (included with the Command Center) in the left side of the unit. Stick the adhesive label over the vent holes on the left side of the top from the inside (Return to step 3).
10. Put your modem into the port on your CPU. Connect the modem line in the unit to the modem. Switch the communication switch on the modem to the telecommunications position. Connect your main telephone line to the telephone jack on the back of the unit. (Illus D). You may now use your modem with the switch on the front plate. When the modem is not being used, leave the switch in the phone position. (Return to step 6).
