

MP3@64 Installation Manual

1. Introduction

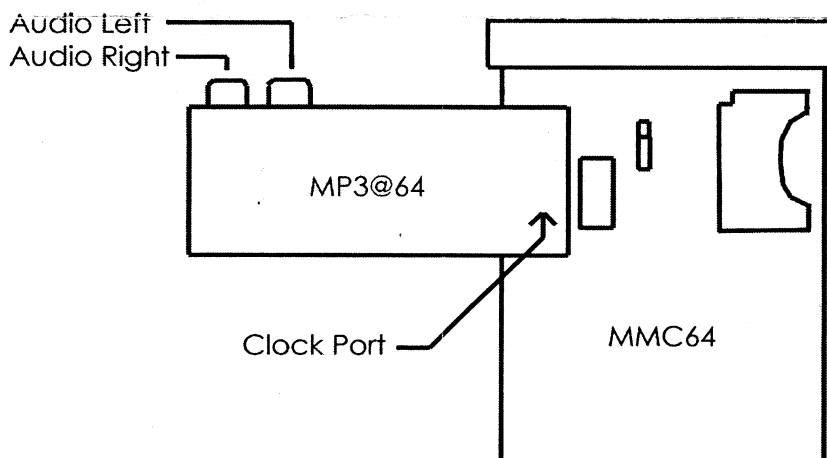
Thank you for purchasing the MP3@64 expansion card. The MP3@64 enables C64/C128 computers equipped with the MMC64 to play MP3 streams up to 320kps at 48khz sampling rate. It also supports streams encoded with variable bit rates.

Key features:

- MAS3507 MP3 decoder chip
- CS4334 24bit, 96khz audio DAC
- Custom designed CPU interface for easy programming

2. Hardware Installation

Remove the MMC64 card while the C64/C128 computer is turned off. Connect the MP3@64 expansion card carefully with the clockport expansion connector located on the upper-left side on your MMC64. **Make carefully sure that both connectors are correctly aligned, since misalignment will damage your equipment!** Now insert your MMC64 back into your C64/C128 computer and connect the MP3@64 to your preferred audio equipment using either the 2 RCA connectors located at the top-left side or the CD-AUDIO connector located at the component side of your card.



3. Software Installation

Visit the Individual Computers homepage <http://www.ami.ga>, and download the MP3 plugin from the **SUPPORT** section. Place the plugin into the **SYSTEM64** directory of your flash card. You can now listen to MP3 files by selecting them using the built-in filebrowser of your MMC64 card. Consult your MMC64 manual for further information regarding plugins and the handling of the filebrowser.
