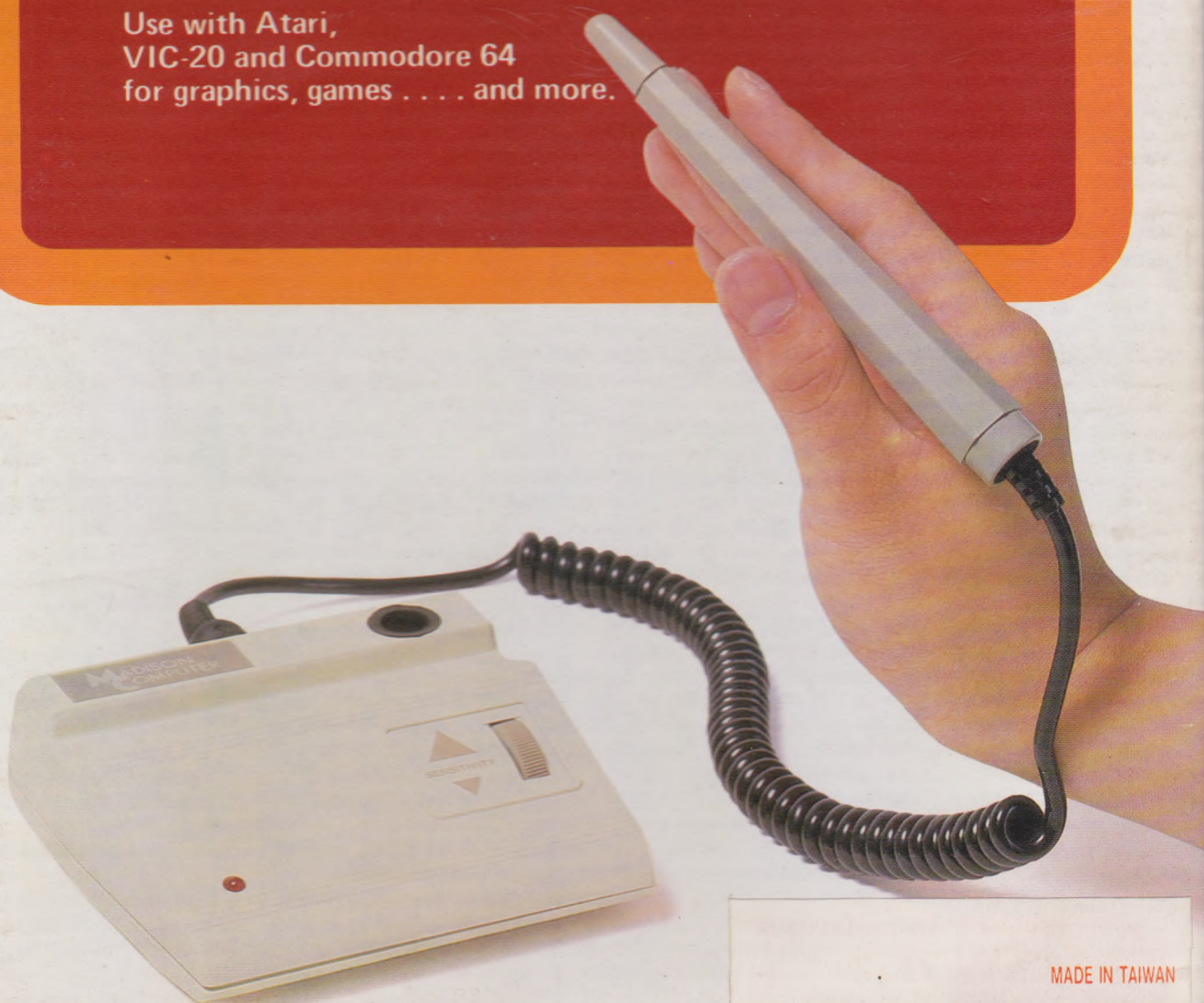

Light Pen Instructions

Installation

Plug MC Pen into joystick (or light pen) port. The light on base will glow when computer is turned on.

Operation

Turn dial on base to lowest sensitivity level.



increase
sensitivity



reduce
sensitivity

Hold pen approximately 1/2 inch from screen, pointing at a light-colored area. Use dial to increase sensitivity and light goes out.

NOTE: If you wish to hold pen closer to screen, decrease sensitivity.

If you wish to hold pen further away from screen, increase sensitivity.

IF LIGHT FAILS TO GO OUT: decrease monitor brightness. If this does not cause the light to go out, consult product manual.
